## **Description**

Scientific Name Cordia gerascanthus

Family Bignoniaceae (Borage)

Native Range West Indies, Mexico, Puerto Rico

Height at Maturity 6-15m

Period until Harvest 30-35 years

Flowering Period April - July

Soil Preference Well-adjusted to alluvial soil

**Light Preference**Full sun to partial shade

Location Preference Thrives in dry areas and limestone hills.









## Care Tips

#### Water (Frequency):

Once every other day, preferably in the early morning or late evening.

#### Pruning (Frequency):

If grown as an ornamental, prune to maintain desirable shape and size.

#### **Common Pests and Treatments:**

In case of an attack by fungus your plant may be treated with fungicides including the following:

- Sulcox
- Ridomil
- Champion
